LB Electrical 12 Car Rally




MDMC members competing

Rally of Derbyshire - 25th February 2023

Rally of Derbyshire rally was run with eleven members driving or navigating in seven cars and others were out in the lanes marshalling. On Sunday the East Riding Stages was run from Beverley in East Yorkshire with three members competing, one driving and the other two navigating.

The Rally of Derbyshire, organised by Matlock Motor Club, was a round of four Regional Championships and attracted an entry of 40 cars. The main route was 105 miles around the lanes of the Peak District but it started with a special test at the go-kart track near to Buxton at 11:00 pm. At midnight the first car set off on the rally route aiming to finish by 4:00 am.

The most successful club member was James Gratton-Smith who finished 3rd driving a MGZR. Richard Oxley finished 8th driving a Proton Satria Gti. Richard Henman and Ken Worf were a commendable 12th in a Peugeot 106 having been seeded at 18. Father and son duo Jason and Jake Simms were 15th also in a Proton. Mark Slatcher and Alistair Leggett were 21st in their BMW Compact but had been running as high as 3rd before encountering some issues. Unfortunately Dennis Cooke and Phil Prosser had to retire their Citroen Saxo. Tom Murphy was navigating but he and his driver also had to retire their BMW two miles into the first section due to broken rear suspension. Every cloud though has a silver lining which meant he got more sleep than expected before navigating the next day in Yorkshire although their luck was then only marginally better. Phil Prosser benefited from retiring early as well because he was also out in Yorkshire on Sunday marshaling on the event.



East Riding Stages - 26th February 2023

The East Riding Stages is a special stage rally on closed public roads. It was the first round of the Protyre Motorsport UK Asphalt Rally Championship and attracted a very high-quality entry of 146 cars that Motorsport News described as sensational and of a quality seldom seen on mainland rallies. A number of cars were only one category down from the World Rally Championship Rally 1. The four special stages run in the morning were repeated in the afternoon giving a total of 45 miles.

The club chairman Lee Burgess and his brother finished a creditable 74th in his Subaru Imprezza. This was his first event for three years and he had been seeded at 107. Tracy Wood navigated for her uncle and finished 75th in a Mitsubishi Evo. Saturday was a somewhat better day for Tom Murphy but he and his driver still had to retire after five stages when in 65th place as the engine was close to blowing up. This was of course a different car to the one they used on Saturday night.



Malcolm Wilson Rally - 11th March February 2023

Tom Murphy, a member of Mid-Derbyshire Motor Club bounced back from two retirements over one weekend in February to record an impressive result on the Malcolm Wilson Rally in the snowy Lake District on Saturday 11th March.

The Malcolm Wilson Rally was a round of both the Motorsport UK British Rally Championship, the BTRDA (British Trials and Rally Drivers Association) Gold and Silver Star Championships as well as a number of others. The entry of 107 cars included two from Malcolm Wilson's MSport, the unofficial works Ford team, one of which was the very latest Ford Puma World Rally Championship car using the event for testing.

Tom Murphy shares his navigation skills primarily between two drivers and on this occasion he was navigating for Andrew (Davo) Davison from Middlesborough in his Vauxhall engined Talbot Sunbeam VXR. They were entered in the BTRDA Silver® Star ® Championship for two wheel drive cars but were also competing against four wheel drive cars in the Gold Star ® Championship. The night before the event started the first three stages that were due to start at 7:30 am were cancelled as they were covered in snow and the forecast was for the temperature to drop to minus 6. This would have resulted in the surface of the stage being potentially lethal. Part of the rally therefore had to be rearranged at the last minute.


The overnight temperature was not as low as forecast but the remaining stages still proved to be a challenge as there were patches of snow and ice to negotiate. Tom and Davo posted very competitive stage times and despite a spin on the second stage that cost them 30 seconds they finished second in class and 15th overall in the BTRDA section of the rally. They were also faster than some of the more powerful four-wheel drive cars. The result was all the more impressive because following a serious roll, without any injuries, in the Grizedale Stages Rally at the end of last year the car had had to be completely rebuilt by Davo's
