
Mid Derbyshire Motor Club Spotlight Newsletter July 2023

<u>Jordan Road Surfacing Stages - 6th August 2023</u>

Worksop & District Motor Club are running a Single-Venue Stage Rally at the former WW2 airfield at Fulbeck, near Newark, on Sunday 6th August 2023.

It's a round of three regional Championships - Clubman Motorsport EMAMC, Alpha Concrete ANEMMC, and Heart of England AWMMC, so there should be plenty of interesting entries.

With experienced organisers, a venue that's not been used for 2 years and which competitors either love or hate, plus a very interesting sponsorship arrangement with Jordan Road Surfacing, it promises to be an entertaining event - oh - and it's non-spectator, too!

Obviously, for the benefit of all the signed-on marshals, I've requested gentle sunshine, a temperature of 18-19C and a slight breeze to blow away any dust, though they're not guaranteed - unlike your voucher for a breakfast bap and drink to get you started, and your entry into the Marshals' cash-prize draw!

Rali Ceredigion - 2nd-3rd September 2023

This will be the third edition of Rali Ceredigion, Wales's original closed road rally and The Rali is one of the most important motorsport events in Wales,

The FIA European Rally Trophy, the Tour European Rally, the Motorsport UK British Rally Championship, the Motorsport UK Protyre Asphalt Championship, the JD Tyres Welsh National Tarmacadam Championship and the HRCR Stage Masters Challenge for Historic rally cars championships are all part of this rally and competitors from all parts of the UK, Ireland and Central Europe are expected to be

This year the start and finish ramp will be located on the promenade in Aberystwyth at the seafront. A ceremonial start kicks off proceedings on the evening of Friday 1st September. The stage action starts on the morning of Saturday 2nd September with a loop of three challenging closed road stages, followed by a lunchtime service halt in Aberystwyth, then a repeat of the three stages in the afternoon. On the Saturday evening, there will be two runs through the Aberystwyth Town Centre stage before the crews progress to Parc Ferme for the overnight halt. Sunday 3rd September brings more closed road stages, a loop of 3 in the morning, followed by a lunchtime service halt, then the same three stages repeated in the afternoon, after which the ceremonial finish will take place at the Promenade in Aberystwyth. The total competitive special stage distance will be approximately 100 miles / 160km.
